3.0	Presentation of the Lung Health Pathway Programme by Claire Corbett and Helen Moreton. A copy of the slides and leaflet for this presentation were circulated to all PPG members prior to the meeting. C.C. and H.M. briefly went through the slides and took numerous questions from PPG members. The overall plan will be for surgeries to notify their patients aged 55-74 about this targeted programme. It is believed that 25,000 patients are eligible and of these 14,000 are believed to be ever smokers. (Ever means a person who has smoked more than 100 cigarettes at some time in their lives). This programme will allow patients to make an appointment with the Lung Health Pathway staff, who will make an initial assessment to see whether a scan might be required dependent on the lung cancer risk level determined for the individual. It is planned that scans will take place at the Community Clacton Diagnostic Centre. This programme will be advertised through mass media to raise public awareness. At the same time Ranworth Surgery will advise all eligible patients in the 55-74 age group
